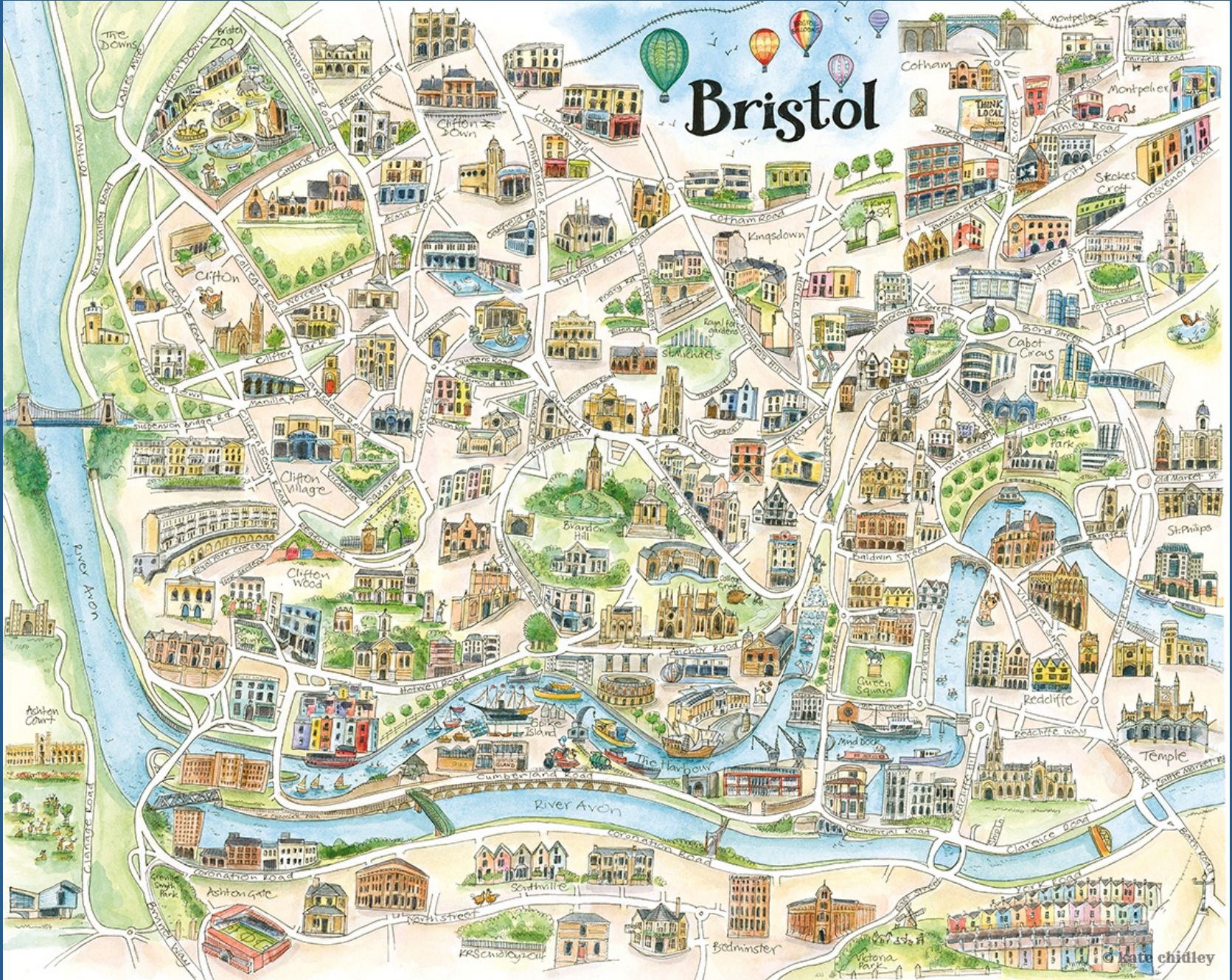

Isambard Kingdom Brunel, the father of British engineering, was born and lived here. He built the first under-river tunnel: he'd be a hero in Norway.

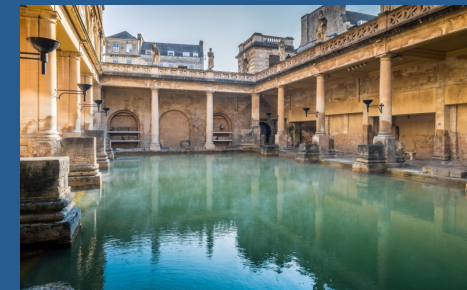


## History ... good and bad

About ten percent of the people in Cardiff speak Welsh (10.5% when we arrive there).

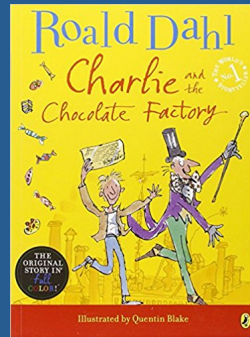
## The city of castles and coal

- it claims to have the most castles of any city in the world.

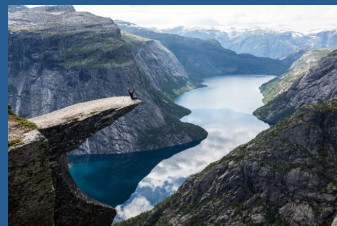


## Something Norwegian..

Roald Dahl, although from Cardiff, had Norwegian parents.

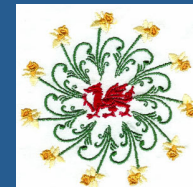


Twinned with Hordaland county (just above Rogaland).

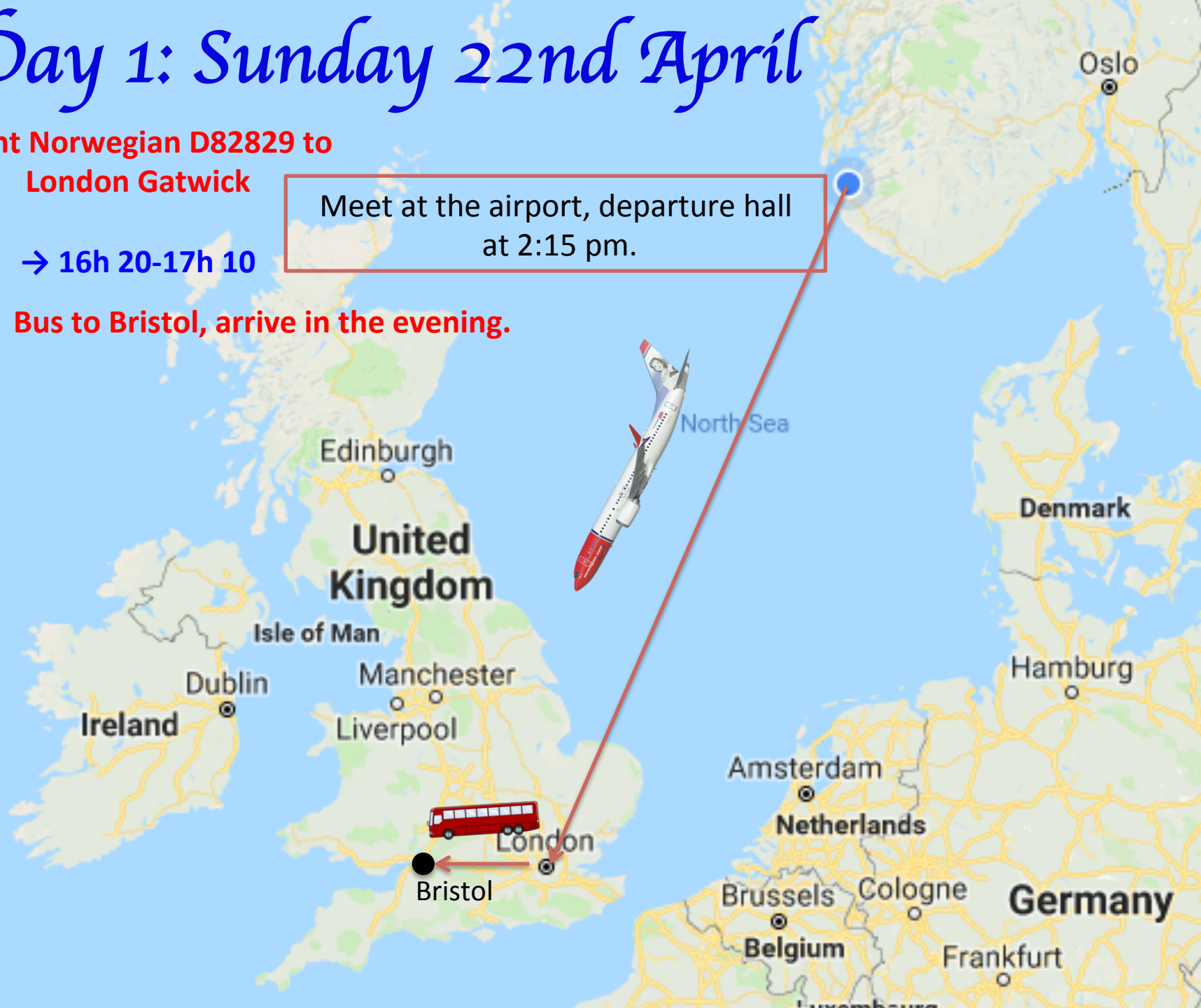
# Day 1: Sunday 22nd April

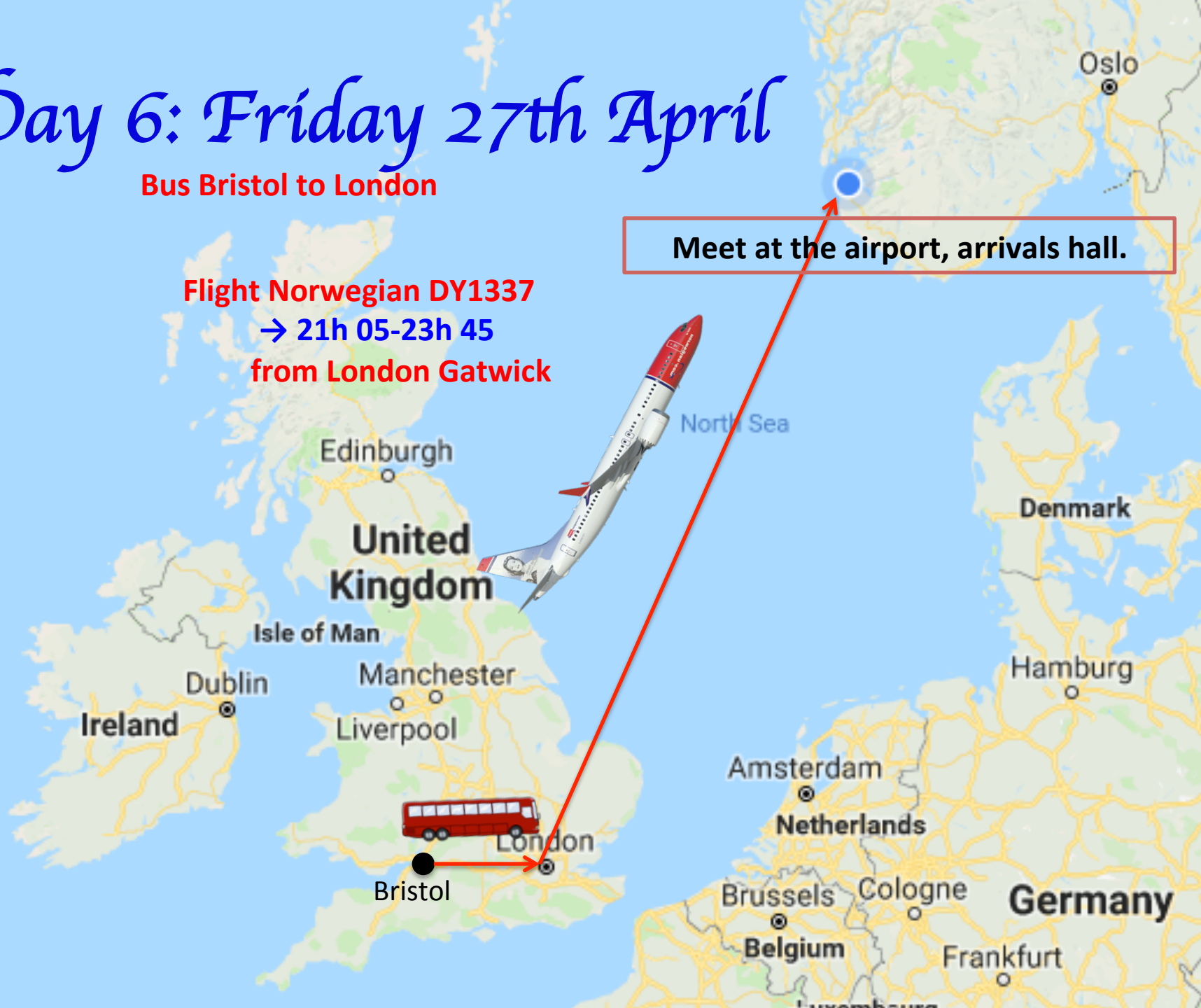

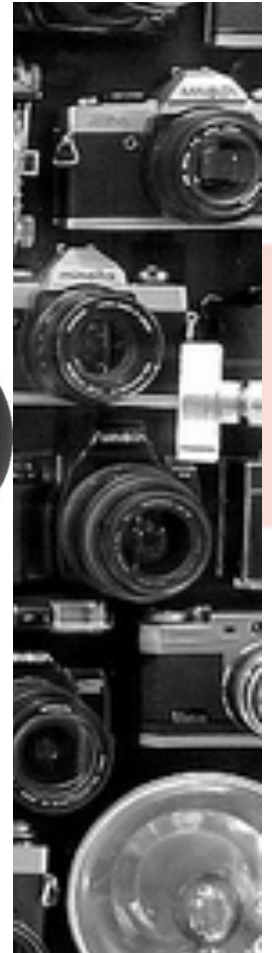
