Angelina Jolie: A Role Model for Women's Rights and Humanitarian Work

Who is she?

Angelina Jolie is an American actress, filmmaker, and humanitarian. She gained worldwide fame for her many roles in greats films like *Maleficent* and won an Academy. Beyond her Hollywood career, she is a UNHCR Special Envoy and a leading advocate for refugee rights, women's empowerment, and the fight against sexual violence in war zones. Her humanitarian work has taken her to over 60 countries, making her one of the most influential celebrity activists in the world.

How Did She Start?

Angelina Jolie first gained fame as a Hollywood actress, winning an Oscar for *Girl*, *Interrupted* (1999). However, her journey as a humanitarian began in 2001 when she filmed *Lara Croft: Tomb Raider* in Cambodia. - In 2014, she organized the Global Summit to End Sexual Violence in Conflict, bringing together world leaders and experts.

3. Supporting Women and Children

- She has funded schools for girls in Afghanistan and Kenya, empowering women through education.
- She co-founded the Jolie-Pitt Foundation, supporting health, education, and women's rights programs.
- She actively works to help survivors of war and sexual violence rebuild their lives.
