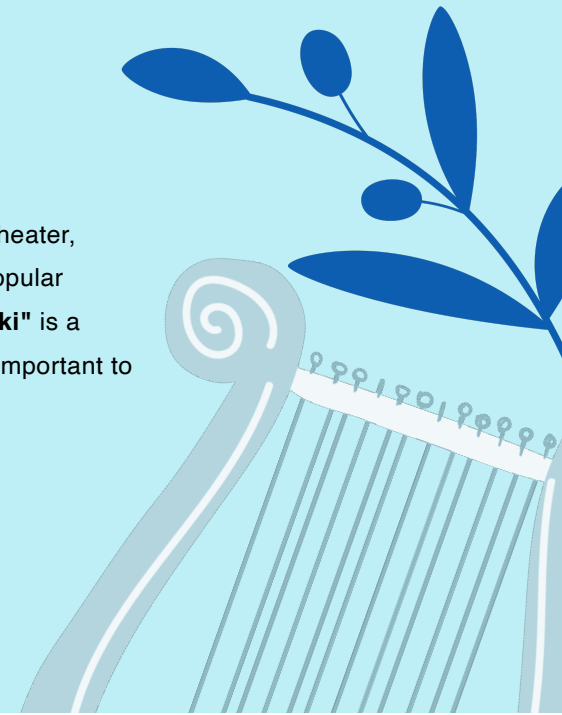

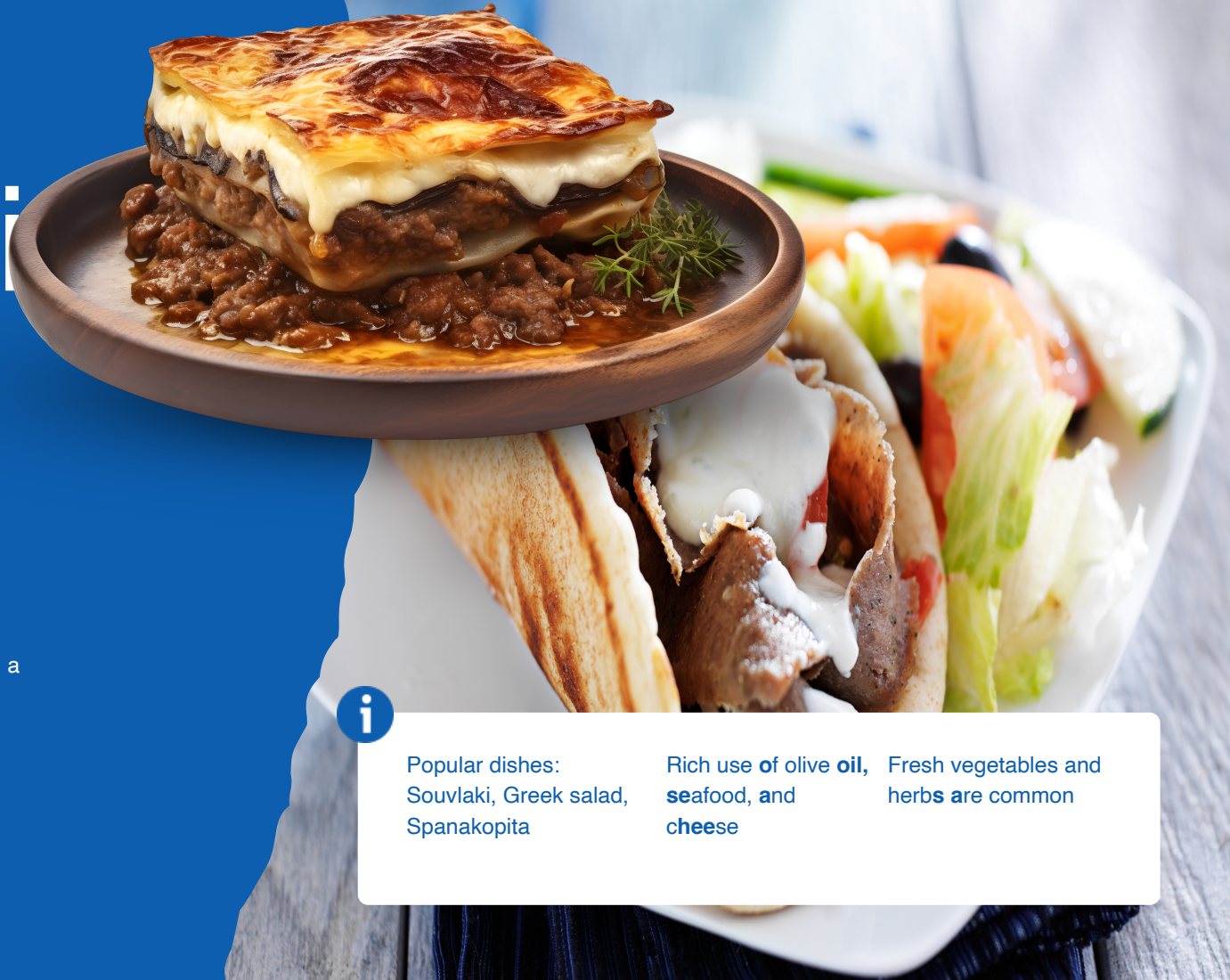

About Greece

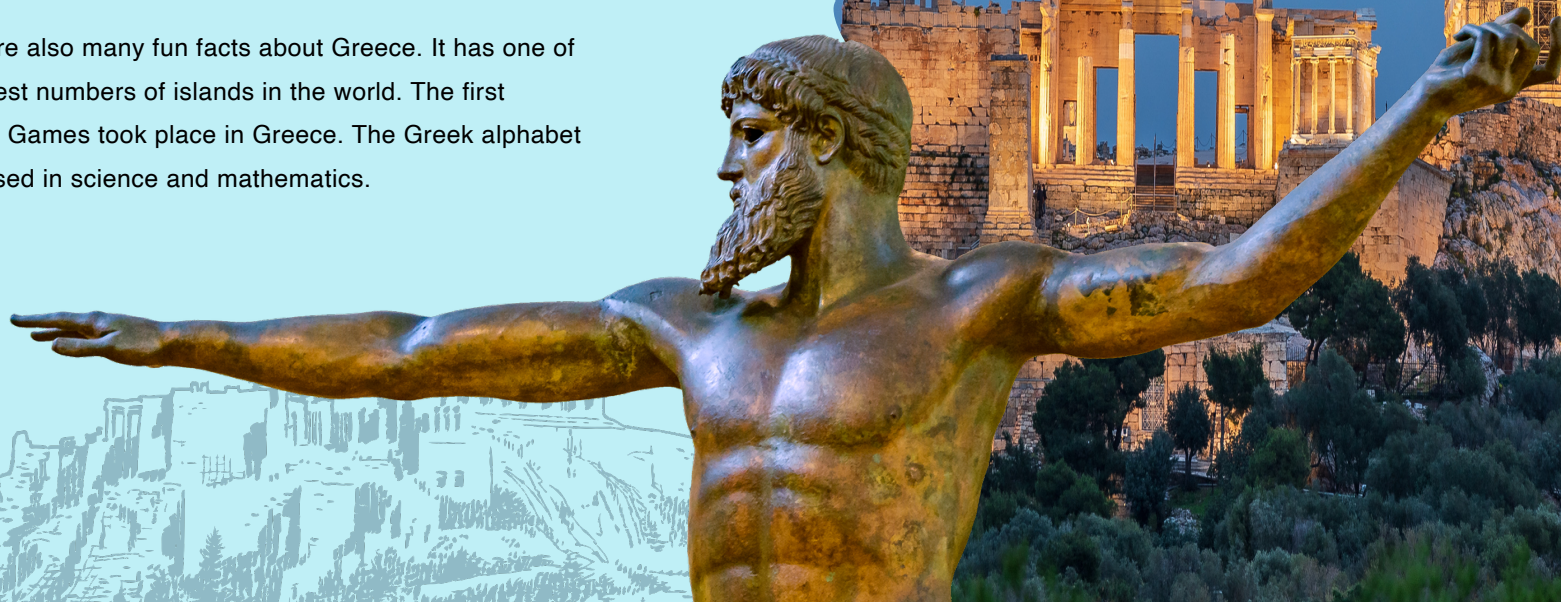
