

PODCAST SCRIPT: Objective* Media

Theme: Identities and Exchange

Duration: Approx. 2-3 minutes (Slow pace)

Speakers: Maya, Léo, Alex, Jordan

(Intro: Short upbeat music fades in)

MAYA:

JORDAN:
